

1st WT Education Committee Meeting (via conference call) September 3, 2019 | 15h00-16h30 (local time Korea)

1. Introduction to the Committee

- a. Functions

2. Welcome and Introduction of Members (Chair)

Chairman thanks the members and members introduced themselves.

3. Discussion and Recommendation

- a. Regulation on Administration of Educators
 - Issue: Qualified potential educators are not able to pass the current Educator Certification Course due to presentation and test in English.
 - Discussion: Delivery of coach course in local languages is more effective, therefore it is necessary to certify qualified educators who do not have good command of English.
 - Recommendation: Amend the Regulation on Administration of Educators to create the category of Educator for Level I Coach Course (English is not restriction).
- b. Registration fee for Level I International Coaches
 - *Issue: There are concerns about the registration fee especially for Level I coach certification course which seems the participants cannot afford.*
 - Discussion: Registration fee for International Coach Certification Course should be determined taking into account the financial situation of the country and capacities of the pertinent MNA.
 - Recommendation: In principle, the registration fee for International Coach Certification Course should be US\$300 for Level II and US\$200 for Level I but WT can adjust the amount taking into account the financial capacity of the country based on the data collected by the WT and GMS team.
- c. Curriculum for Level I, II International Coaches
 - Issue: There are demands for providing technical program for actual athlete training at least at the level I coach course.
 - Discussion
 - The curriculum for Level and Level II should be identical.
 - It is essential to allow use of local language during the coach course.



- In general, the certification course should be focused on capacity building and creating more access to participants rather than generating revenue.
- So far, there is not much benefit for Level coach course.
- Recommendation:
 - The curriculum for coach course should be identical for the time being with more online education supplemented.
 - Benefit for Level I coach course should be considered.
- d. Status of Online Education Platform

 \succ The Chair briefs the status of the development of online education platform. There has been a series of meetings between Education committee (former), WT administration, GMS and Simplycompete to create the WT online education platform. There will be two ways; (1) posting as many educational materials as possible on the education section on WT website for easy access of public (2) managing certification courses via Simplycompete online platform (registration, exam, etc).

e. Education Contents Development

 \succ There is a proposal from EGS for creation of education contents focused on videos. WT is currently working on reviewing the proposal. Once the proposal is accepted, the contents will be produced.

f. Integration of E-Sports

 \succ Committee agrees to discuss this matter at the next meeting with participation of Mr. Chong Ng, the one contracted with WT for E-sport development.

4. Other Matters

- Committee agrees to organize a conference call on a Monthly basis.
- Committee agrees to keep same time (15h00, local time Korea) for the conference call.

5. Next Committee Meeting

- Next conference call will be held at 15h00 local time in Korea on October 1, 2019.

6. Closing of Meeting

- Chair thanks the members and WT administration for support, and asks the WT administration to provide the meeting summary together with the related amendment proposal of the regulation.
